 アメリカの最高裁判所(the Supreme Court)で2人目の女性判事として、性差別問題を巡る数々の裁判 を手掛けたことで知られるルース・ベイダー・ギンズバーグ氏(Ruth Bader Ginsburg)についての英文を 読んで、後に続く問いに答えなさい。

Ruth Bader Ginsburg was a well-known and respected judge who spent 27 years on the Supreme Court of the United States. She was the second woman to ever hold this position and the first Jewish woman. ①<u>Ginsberg</u> [7 and helping 1 fighting for 2 known for \pm to 2 equal rights 2 was] make the world a better place for women and other groups that were treated unfairly.

Ruth Bader Ginsburg was born in Brooklyn, New York in 1933. She was always a good student and was successful (A) her studies. She studied at a famous university and then went to law school, and $2 \frac{\text{that}}{\text{tmax}}$ was a great success for a woman at that time. Though she faced many challenges as a woman in a field **7** (influence) heavily by men, Ginsburg did well and graduated with excellent academic records.

After law school, Ginsburg worked as an assistant judge and then became a law professor. She taught at Rutgers Law School and then at Columbia Law School. (**B**) this time, she also worked with the $(\underline{*} 1)$ American Civil Liberties Union's Women's Rights Project ③ to help women have the same rights as men. Ginsburg became a well-known and respected voice in the fight for women's rights.

In 1980, President ($\underline{*}2$)Jimmy Carter chose Ginsburg to work in ($\underline{*}3$)the United States Court of Appeals in Washington, D.C. She served on this court for 13 years. (**B**) that time, she kept speaking up for women's rights and people's freedoms. In 1993, President ($\underline{*}4$)Bill Clinton picked Ginsburg for the Supreme Court, and almost everyone in ($\underline{*}5$)the Senate agreed (**C**) the choice.

As a Supreme Court justice, Ginsburg was famous because she had strong opinions and worked for equal rights. She wrote important opinions about ($\underline{*}6$)discrimination \checkmark (base) on sex and other forms of ($\underline{*}7$)prejudice, and she was a strong supporter of ($\underline{*}8$)reproductive rights and access to healthcare. Thanks (**D**) her efforts, the idea of equality and ($\underline{*}9$)fairness greatly improved.

Ginsburg never gave up \mathbf{r} (fight) for justice and equality. She did a lot of important work that will continue to encourage and guide people who fight for women's rights and civil liberties in the future. She has shown that one person can make a difference and change the world through their life and work.

Many people around the world were sad when Ginsburg died in September 2020. She is an inspiration to people all over the world, a leader, and a strong supporter of fairness. She kept believing in herself even though it was hard, and her work continues to motivate and inspire others.
