Various **motifs** are popular for sweater designs! For example, **secular** Christmas **symbols** like Santa Claus, **reindeer**, Christmas trees, candy canes, presents, **gingerbread** men, candy, **nutcrackers**, etc.

**Seasonal** winter **themes** like **snowflakes**, snowmen, ice skating, evergreens, **wreathes**, winter flowers, **fluffy** animals like bears, etc. are nice too.

Pop culture **references** pop up more and more these days. Famous characters from Disney like Mickey or Pluto, childhood **cartoon** characters like SpongeBob or Elmo, or classic **brand** characters like the Pillsbury Doughboy are common. **Iconic** characters from **beloved** Christmas movies are also easy to spot.
